WITH LOVE FROM ITALY

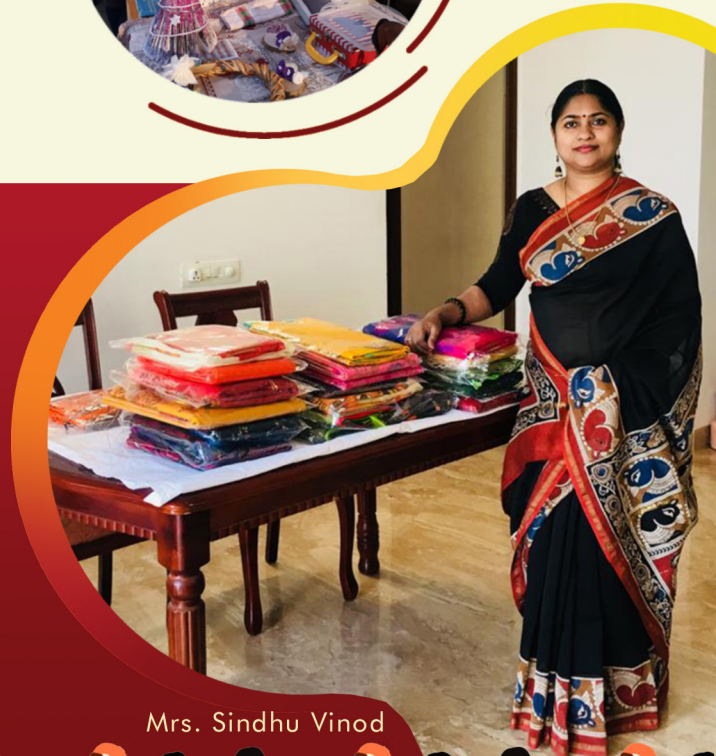

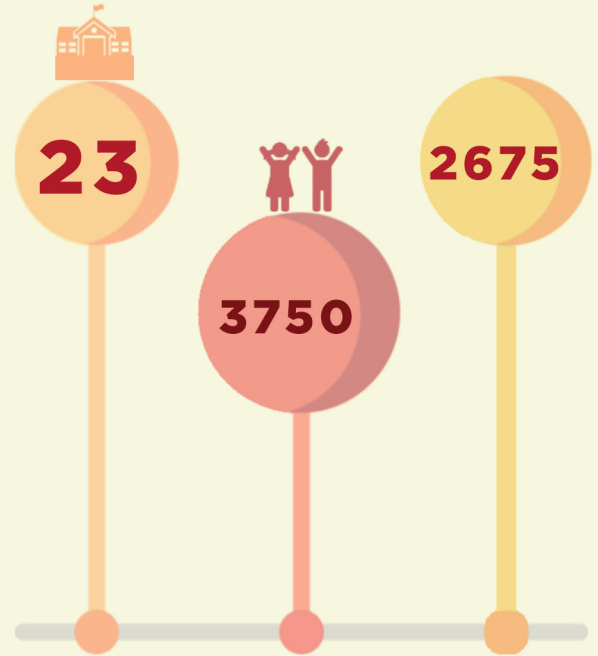
