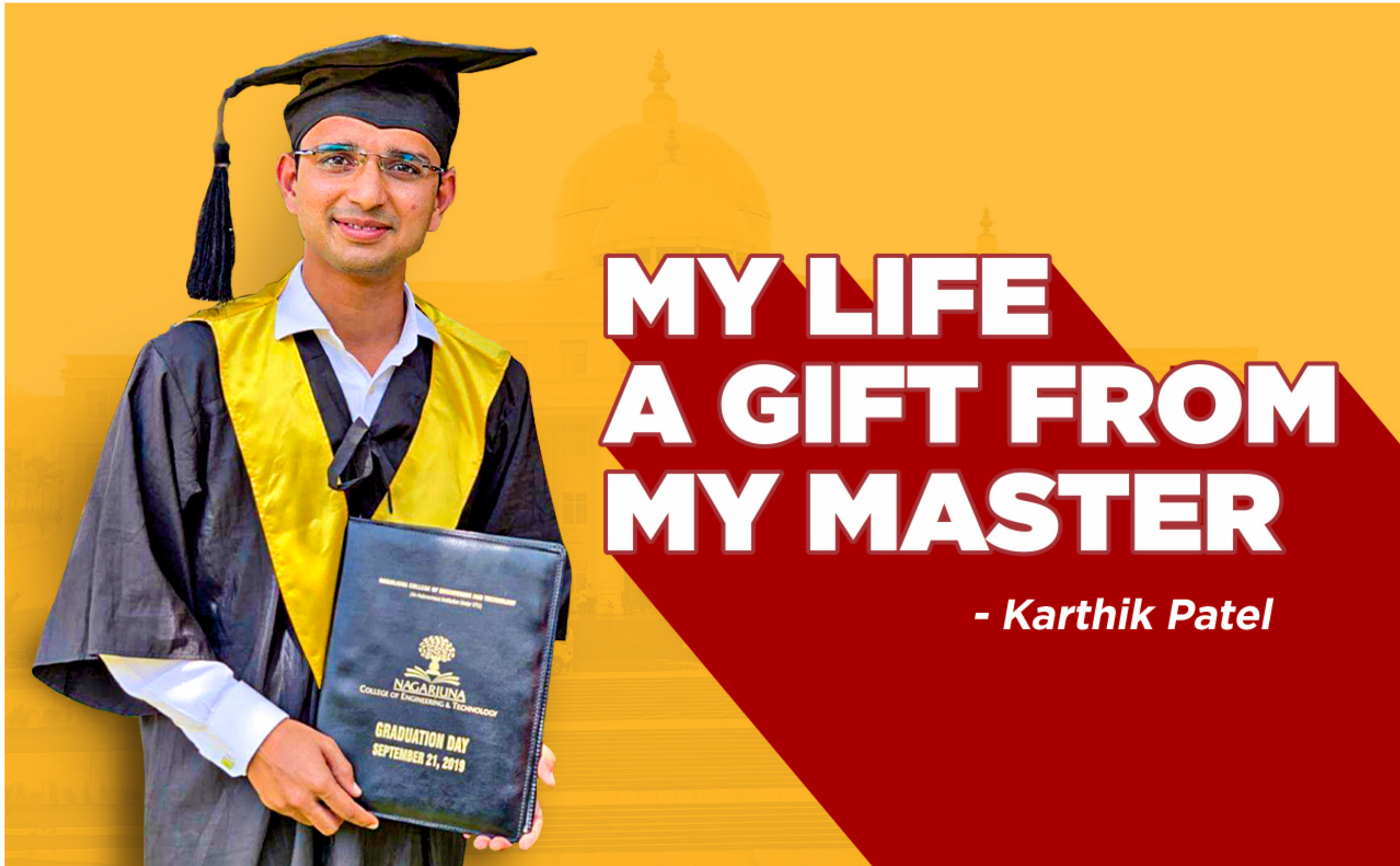

As I continued to do what I enjoyed the most and felt that I had everything that one could aspire for, my Master guided me to enrol myself for M. 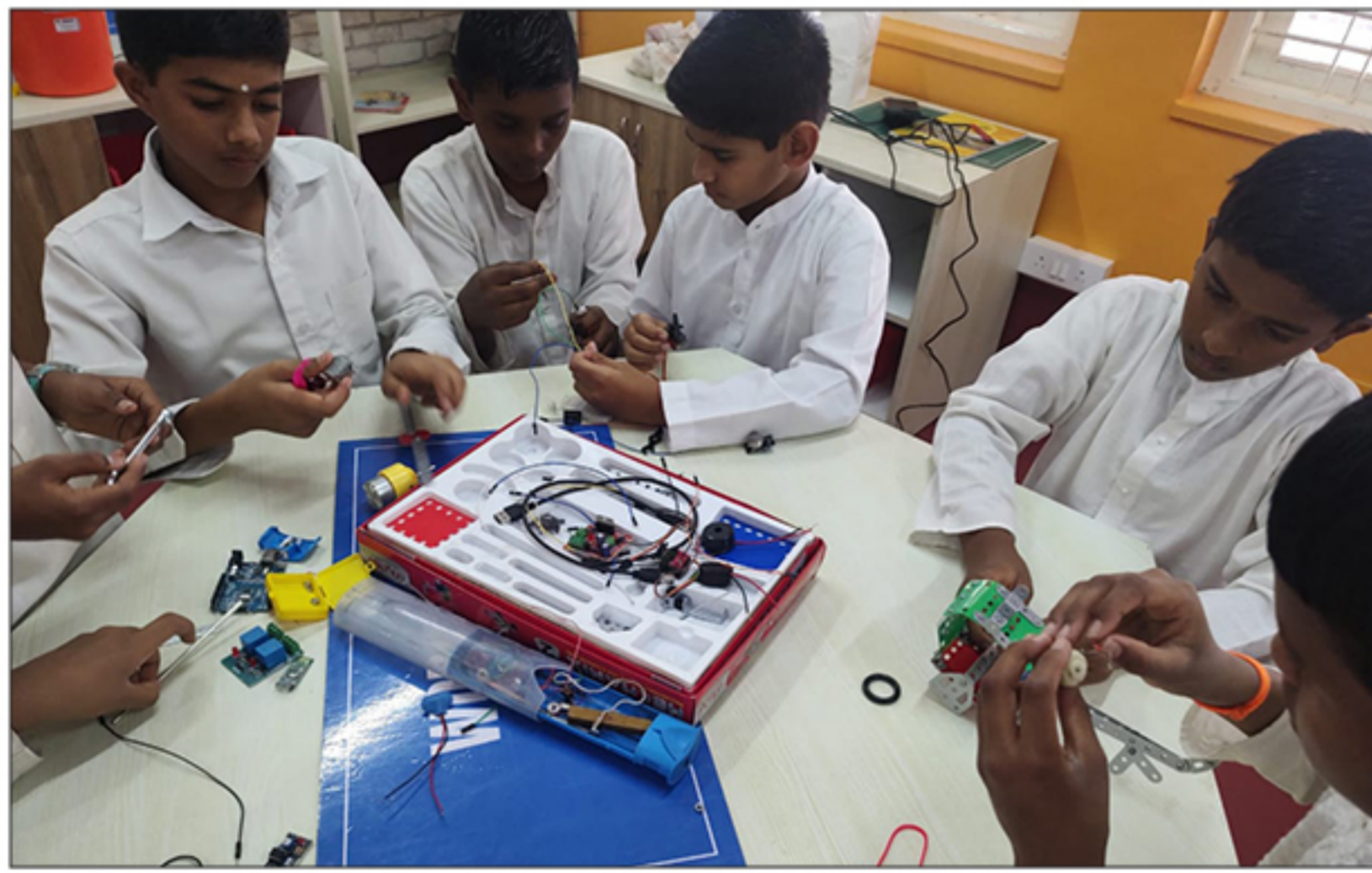




# CAMPUS UPDATES

## A. ATAL TINKERING LAB

The ATAL TINKERING LAB is an initiative by Niti Aayog - a Government of India undertaking, to encourage innovation and creativity among students. These labs are set-up in schools across India with the vision to cultivate "One million children in India as Neoteric Innovators". ATL labs allow students to experiment and develop practical solutions to real world problems. With the help of M/s Dell Technologies and the Hope Foundation Collaborative, an ATAL Lab has been set up at the Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulam in Muddenahalli, providing access to nearly 600 students from our campuses located in and around Chikkaballapur district. The lab is equipped with a variety of tools and materials that students can use to create their own projects. The tools include 3D printers, laser cutters, microcontrollers and sensors. This ATL has been a most welcome enabler and facilitator in our endeavour to develop and foster a scientific temper in our students.





## **B. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROJECT - RURAL DEVELOPMENT THROUGH RURAL ENGAGEMENT**

Community Engagement Programmes are an integral part of our education system. They afford our children an opportunity to imbibe the qualities of social responsibility, generosity, innovative thinking, and problem solving. As a part of this activity, the students of the 3rd year undergraduate programme recently undertook a rural development project covering four villages in the Kalaburagi district of Karnataka - Navanihala, Kamalapur, Okali and Belakota. The students were divided into teams and assigned one village each. Each team along with their teacher-in-charge interacted and engaged with the locals of their assigned village to have a better understanding of the on-ground realities. They learnt about the daily lives of the villagers, their economic activities, education system, medical facilities, culture and heritage, and the challenges faced by them every day. The teams found that agriculture and daily wage works are the primary sources of income in these villages. However, some villagers also engage in livestock farming, weaving and pottery. Lack of support for their businesses mainly due to lack of adequate infrastructure was one of their major concerns. So, as a next step, the students will be involved in conducting drives to spread awareness about various government schemes for rural development and providing support for implementation of the beneficial schemes. Our students are provided many such opportunities every year with the objective of facilitating an understanding of the problems on the ground and finding practical, sustainable solutions to them.

### Cost Break-up





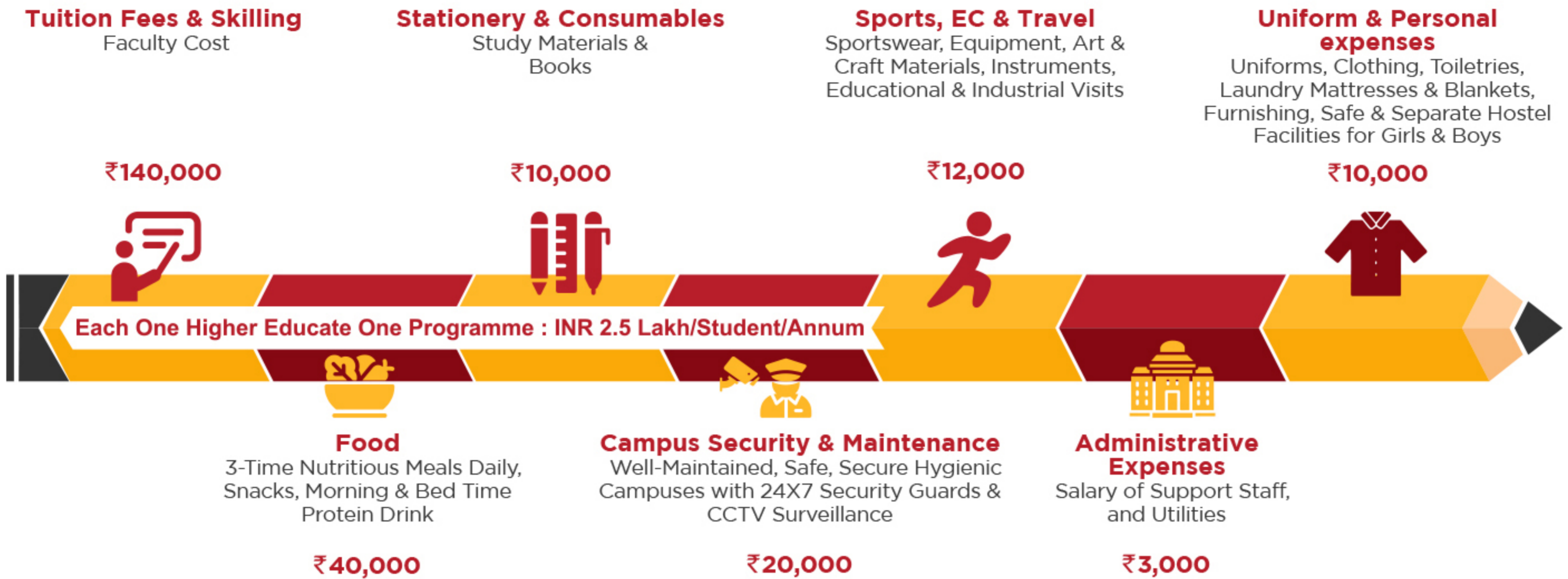


# EACH ONE HIGHER EDUCATE ONE

## Cost Break-up

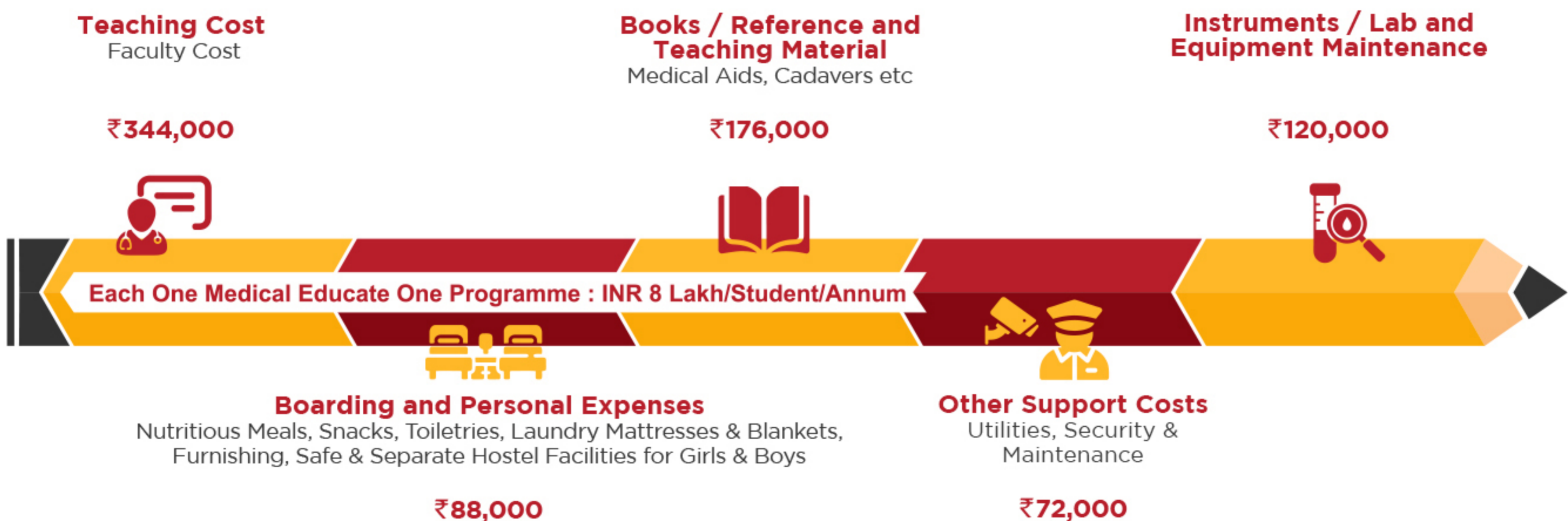


# EACH ONE MEDICAL EDUCATE ONE

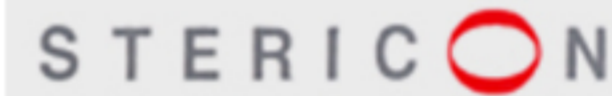
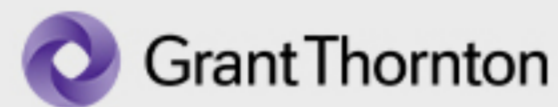
