




PRESENTED HONORARY DOCTORATES **TO 6 EMINENT INDIAN CITIZENS**

3. GLOBAL CONFERENCE ON VEDIC IDEAS FOR A BETTER SOCIETY



Ms Meera Mehra

In this issue of our newsletter celebrating Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, commemorating 75 years of India's independence and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements, we are proud to feature a true patriot from Australia - our E1E1 champion Ms Meera Mehra. Ms. Meera Mehra's dedication to the cause of under served children in rural India is exemplary, and demonstrates how even an individual residing thousands of miles away can still be an effective agent for change back home.

Ms Meera Mehra is a proud alumna of the Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Anantapur campus, which was the very first higher education institution founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, way back in 1968, exclusively for women. "The level of education among women decides whether a country will prosper or decline", is what Bhagawan Baba had proclaimed at the inauguration of this institution by the then Honorable President of India, Sri V V Giri, more than 5 decades ago; in an age and time when there was hardly any media coverage or public discourse on girl child education and women's empowerment! Ms. Meera Mehra who hails from Allahabad joined this institution in 1976 for her intermediate and finished her Bachelors in Science in 1981.

The free-of-cost education (a hallmark of Bhagawan Baba's educational mission (well before the RTE Act was passed in 2008) that young Meera received, instilled human values in her that have become an integral part of her life since then, demonstrating how this unique approach towards holistic education and integral development can bring about a lasting transformation in an individual. She recalls that within the college environment, she learnt how important it was to appreciate the existence of different cultures, languages, and beliefs — acknowledging and respecting mutual coexistence, as students from all

backgrounds, castes, regions, religions, and social strata lived together in harmony.

According to Ms Mehra, the education she received at the institute forms the basis of her leading a purposeful life today, engaged in serving and enabling the next generation to carry on the legacy of this holistic model of education. As an active volunteer of the Each One Educate One Foundation, she doesn't just stop with her personal generosity to invest in the education and bright future of the next generation. She goes well beyond her own comfort zone, and strives hard to not just spread the word, but actually garner more and more support for the education of rural under served children studying in our campuses, through her network of friends, relatives and like-minded individuals in the local community there and back home in India. This, despite having moved to Melbourne decades ago and settling down with family over there. With her continuing efforts, leadership and passion, she has helped make a significant difference in the lives of underserved children in Rural India, drawing immense satisfaction and a sense of higher fulfillment that nothing else can offer her, she affirms.

In her own words, "Educating children from underprivileged, and marginalised sections of the society is a cause very close to my heart and hence, I decided to give it my very best shot in terms of my time and efforts, and the capacity that I have been blessed with and am grateful for. I have this strong conviction that every individual has a definite role to play towards the community and the motherland, by setting an example through one's own actions in life no matter where or how one is. I find great fulfillment in ensuring that the transformative education I was fortunate to receive, reaches many more needy and under served rural children, empowering them to lead lives of dignity and becoming instruments of change themselves."










07. CSR Corner
