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# Empowering Future Researchers through Hands-on Bioinformatics Training

**T**he Department of Life Sciences at **Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence**, Karnataka, organised a six-day hybrid workshop titled **“Hands-on Training in Bioinformatics: From Sequences to Systems”** from April 6–11, 2026, at the Muddenahalli Campus.

Bringing together nearly 100 participants, including students, research scholars, and faculty members, the workshop featured:

- The successful introduction of participants to practical bioinformatics workflows, strengthening their confidence in applying computational tools to biological research.
- Interactive sessions, hands-on training, real-world data analysis, and direct engagement with leading researchers, making the programme highly impactful and well received.
- Insights from expert resource persons on the expanding research opportunities in bioinformatics, encouraging participants to explore its vast potential in interdisciplinary scientific research and innovation.

## Workshop Highlights

Expert sessions by distinguished resource persons from IISc, NIT Warangal, Bharathiar University, KLEF University, and Siddaganga Institute of Technology.

Covered key bioinformatics domains, including biological databases, molecular phylogenetics, homology modelling, molecular docking, gene expression analysis, and systems biology.

Combined conceptual lectures with hands-on training, enabling participants to gain practical experience with contemporary bioinformatics tools and workflows.

The event concluded with participant feedback, certificate distribution, and a collective acknowledgement of the growing importance of computational approaches in modern life sciences research.

# Building Global Bridges through the Arts

**S**ri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence (SSSUHE) strengthened its global academic and cultural footprint by signing three significant Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with leading institutions in Vienna.

These partnerships reflect the University's commitment to fostering artistic excellence, intercultural dialogue, and meaningful educational collaboration.

- The first MoU, signed with **SUPERAR Vienna**, focuses on expanding access to music education through artistic and academic exchange. The collaboration includes joint workshops, performances, faculty development, and the sharing of innovative pedagogical practices, creating opportunities for students to experience diverse musical traditions.
- The second partnership with **Natya Mandir, Vienna** establishes a five-year collaboration dedicated to Indian classical dance. Through workshops, lecture demonstrations, performances, artist residencies, faculty and student exchanges, and joint cultural initiatives, the MoU aims to preserve and promote the rich heritage of Bharatanatyam while encouraging cross-cultural learning.
- Completing the trio of collaborations, **SSSUHE entered into a partnership with the Music and Arts University of the City of Vienna (MUK)** to promote excellence in music education and performance. The agreement facilitates academic exchanges, guest lectures, collaborative concerts, curriculum development, faculty development in Music and Technology, and comparative study of Indian and Western music systems.

Together, these three MoUs mark a significant milestone in SSSUHE's journey towards becoming a global centre for excellence in performing arts, nurturing talent through international partnerships while advancing the vision of One World, One Family.





These collaborations formed a part of an Arts & Cultural Festival in Vienna in June 2026. The festival also sponsored performances by the students of SSSUHE, showcasing the rapid progress made by the students of the Department of Performing Arts, reflected in the spectacular performances rendered by the Sai Symphony Orchestra and the Nada Gurukulam Bharatanatyam overseas students.

Twenty-four student musicians of the Sai Symphony Orchestra, under the direction of Dr Dimitris Lambrianos, performed alongside internationally acclaimed artistes, including Dr L. Subramaniam, Mrs Kavita Krishnamurti Subramaniam, and Shri Ambi Subramaniam creating a remarkable musical experience that celebrated unity through music.

## Best Paper Award at International AI Conference

The Department of Mathematical and Computational Sciences proudly celebrates a remarkable research achievement by Vineesha Thurai, a final-year M.Sc. Computer Science student, who received the Best Paper Award at the 2026 International Conference on Applied Artificial Intelligence (2AI-2026).

Hosted by the Central University of Kashmir in collaboration with USD Artificial Intelligence (AI) Research, the conference attracted over 500 research paper submissions from across the globe. Of these, only 118 papers were selected for presentation, with the University's research securing an impressive 5th position overall.

Their award-winning paper, “**Explainable AI-Driven Severity Prediction: Comparing Random Split and Patient-Wise Validation Using Voice Features of Parkinson’s Disease and Machine Learning**,” highlights the transformative potential of Healthcare AI and Explainable AI (XAI) in enhancing the monitoring and assessment of Parkinson’s disease severity.



We extend our heartfelt congratulations to Vineesha Thurai and Prof. Dr. Sathyanarayanan S, Head of the Department and her research guide, on this prestigious recognition.

Their achievement is a matter of immense pride for the institution and reflects its continued commitment to academic excellence and research.
