

Rather than highlighting differences, the curatorial vision gently guided visitors to recognise the underlying unity that flows through humanity's varied cultural expressions.

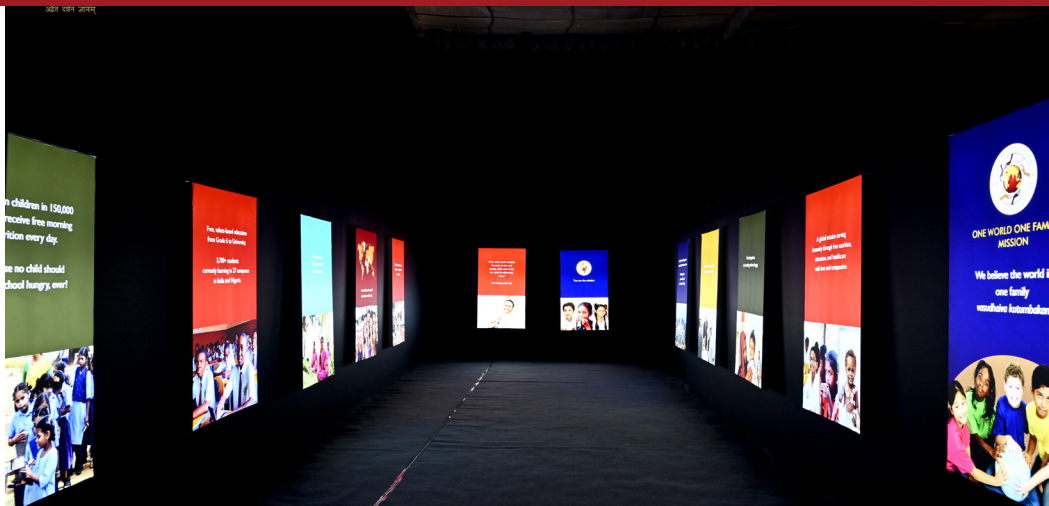

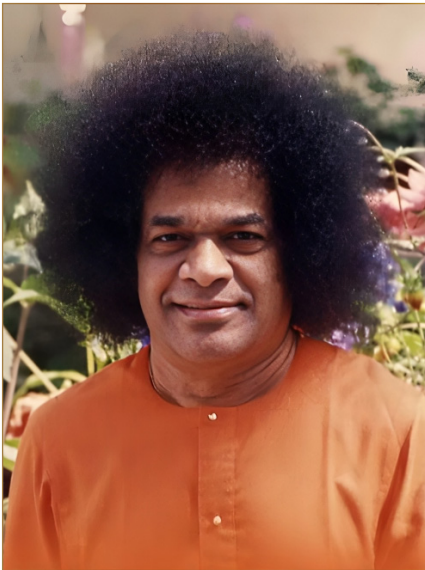
Statue of Love

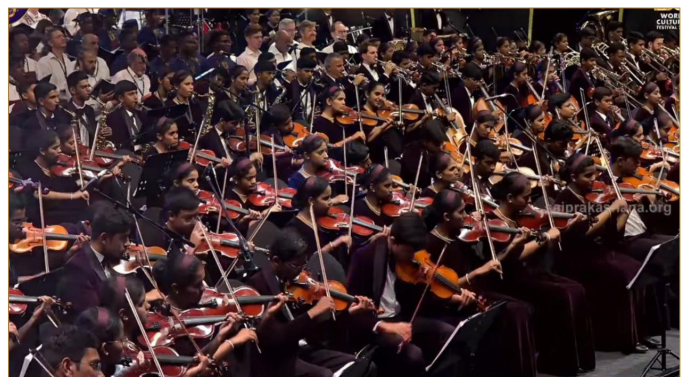

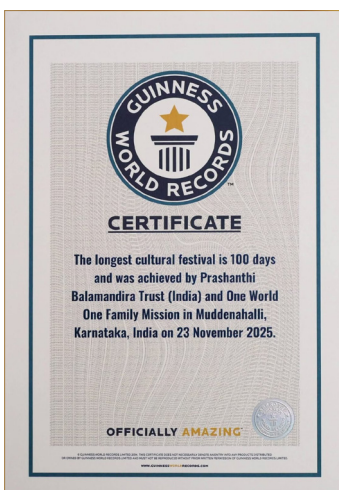
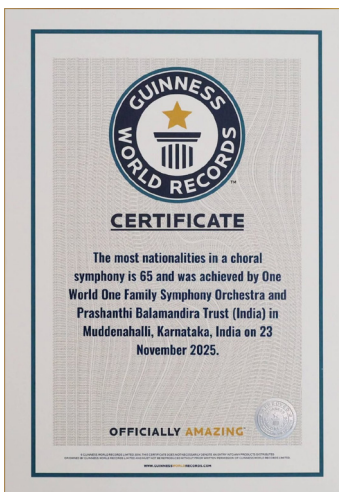

The chant echoed the profound Indian wisdom that views the physician not merely as a professional, but as an instrument of healing and service.

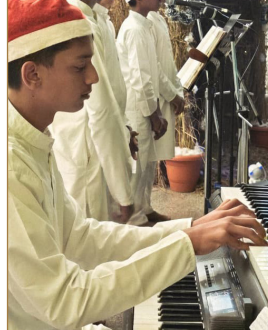
This meaningful observance reaffirmed SMSIMSR's commitment to nurturing doctors who are not only clinically competent but also ethically grounded and socially conscious.

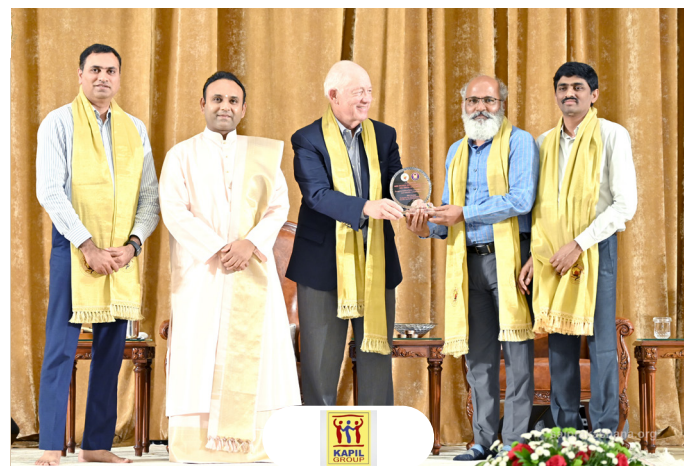

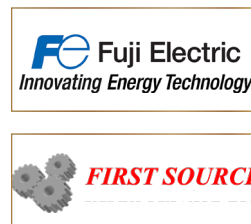
