In His benedictory address, the Chancellor exhorted the graduates to uphold the spirit of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam – the idea that the whole world is one family.







The prestigious award was presented during the Edu Tech Expo 2025, held on 22–23 August 2025 in Hyderabad.



Institutions operate on the principle of values-based, holistic education, aiming to unlock the highest potential in every child. While our Gurukulam model nurtures students in rural and underserved communities with free education, nutrition and holistic development, we also constantly seek innovative ways to enhance academic excellence.



To this end, we are delighted to announce our partnership with Scikraft, a Bengaluru-based educational services organization committed to redefining the way Science is taught in classrooms. Together, we are bringing Xperimentor, Scikraft's flagship offering, into the classrooms of Grades 6 to 8 at Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulam (SSSLSG) institutions, beginning with a pilot at Karwar and Chikkaballapura Campuses.

# **About Xperimentor: Bringing the**Lab into the Classroom

In most conventional classrooms, Science is often reduced to theory, memorisation and textbook-based learning. Scikraft challenges this status quo through Xperimentor - a carefully designed classroom solution that enables students to learn by doing.

Aligned with school curricula for Grades 6 to 10, the Xperimentor program includes:

- A comprehensive resource kit containing reusable and consumable materials for hands-on group activities and teacher-led demonstrations
- A workbook for each student, allowing them to engage with structured quests and exercises
- The Xperimentor app, which offers a library of curriculum-aligned topics, bite-sized learning quests, and built-in assessments

Everything a student or teacher needs to explore Science concepts is made available, within the classroom itself, avoiding the necessity to go to a separate Science Lab.









A comprehensive induction and training program equips educators with the principles of inquiry-based learning and guides them in effectively integrating the tools and resources into their lesson plans.

Teachers engage in hands-on sessions using the new methodology, enabling a smooth transition from conventional instruction to facilitating experiential learning. With ongoing support and access to physical and digital resources, they confidently lead interactive and engaging Science classes.

#### **Early Impact: A New Joy in Learning**

The impact of the Xperimentor pilot has been immediate and inspiring:

- Teachers at both campuses are now comfortable in using Xperimentor to make Science lessons interactive and engaging.
- Students are showing a newfound enthusiasm for Science. They actively participate in hands-on experiments, collaborate in small groups, and take ownership of their learning.



 Peer learning and curiosity have increased, with students often helping one another and showing eagerness to attempt Quizzes and Assessments on the app.

This marks a paradigm shift in the learning environment from passive absorption to active exploration.

#### A Shared Vision: Building the Next Generation of Innovators

Through Xperimentor, we hope to remove the fear often associated with Science and instead cultivate a spirit of inquiry, discovery, and innovation. By making classrooms vibrant hubs of experimentation, we aim to inspire students from rural and under-resourced backgrounds to pursue careers in STEM fields that have long felt out of reach for them.

We envision scaling this program across all SSSLSG campuses. 


