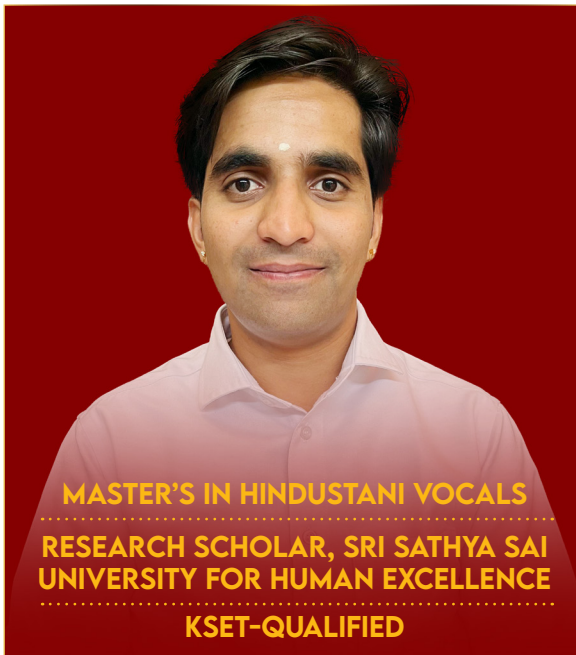

An alumnus of the Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva institutions, he completed his schooling at Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulam, Muddenahalli, followed by a Bachelor's degree in Humanities and a Master's degree in Hindustani Vocals from Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence. He is KSET-qualified and holds junior and senior grade certifications in Hindustani Vocals, Carnatic

Vocals, and Harmonium from the Karnataka Education Board. Currently serving as an Assistant Professor of Hindustani Vocals and a Research Scholar at Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence, Pranav actively contributes to music education and research. His performances have been featured at renowned venues across India, including Kalakshetra (Chennai) and Pandharpur (Maharashtra), and internationally across Australia, Singapore, Fiji, Italy, Sri Lanka, and the United Kingdom.

Equally proficient in classical and light music forms such as Bhajans, Abhangs, Vachanas, and Dasara Padas, Pranav has earned accolades at state, zonal, and national levels.

Growing up in a small rural village where girls' education was often discouraged, I never imagined studying beyond the 10th standard. My dreams felt fragile under the weight of societal expectations.

The blessed opportunity to join Sri Sathya Sai Prashanthi Bala Mandira, Chikkaballapur, and later Sri Sathya Sai Prashanthiniketanam, where I received free, value-based education, transformed my life. I eventually pursued my graduation and post-graduation at the Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence. These institutions gave me more than education; they gave me identity, purpose, and a life rooted in character and values. Coming from a Kannada-medium background, the transition to English medium education was

challenging. I even failed one subject during my pre-university exams. But I was given a second chance. That moment changed everything. I stopped studying for marks and began learning for transformation. I was introduced to Paravidya, the higher knowledge that leads to self-realisation, and understood that the true goal of education is enlightenment, not just employment.

With God's grace, I completed my graduation with a 9.5 CGPA and later cleared the Karnataka State Eligibility Test (KSET), becoming eligible to teach as an Assistant Professor in Biology—the very subject I once failed. This achievement is a living testimony to the transformative power of this institution.

INDUSTRIAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SSSUHE STUDENTS

MONARCH BIOTECH PVT. LTD., CHENNAI



The microbiology sessions provided exposure to culture media preparation, sterilization techniques, microbial testing procedures, and colony counting methods. Additionally, students gained insights into advanced analytical techniques, including sample preparation methods for chromatographic analysis. Demonstrations of sophisticated instruments such as HPLC, GC-MS, ICP-MS, and ICP-OES broadened their understanding of trace-level contaminant detection and modern food safety practices.

The training also highlighted the role of regulatory bodies such as FSSAI in maintaining food safety standards and laboratory accreditation. Overall, the program significantly enhanced students' technical competence, analytical skills, and awareness of industrial quality systems, preparing them for future careers in research, quality assurance, and analytical sciences.

Students of Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence recently completed an intensive industrial training program at Monarch Biotech Private Limited, Chennai, gaining valuable exposure to real-time laboratory practices in food, water, and environmental analysis. The program was designed to bridge the gap between academic learning and industrial applications, providing hands-on experience with modern analytical techniques and laboratory standards.

During the training, students were introduced to the structure and functioning of an industrial testing laboratory, including workflow management, quality assurance practices, safety protocols, and regulatory compliance. They received practical training in water analysis, performing chemical parameter estimations through standardized titration methods. In food analysis, students conducted proximate analysis to determine moisture, ash, protein, and fat content, while understanding the importance of precision and accuracy in quality testing.



BRIDGING CLASSROOM LEARNING WITH REAL WORLD EXPERIENCE

SSSUHE STUDENTS INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SERVOCONTROLS & HYDRAULICS (INDIA) PVT. LTD.

Students of Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence (SSSUHE), Girls Campus undertook an industrial visit to Belagavi from 26th to 28th February 2026 as part of their academic curriculum to gain practical exposure to industrial operations and management practices.

The visit to Servocontrols & Hydraulics (India) Pvt. Ltd. provided insights into servo-hydraulic systems, precision engineering, and their applications in aerospace and defence. Students learned about design processes, CNC machining, quality testing, and export-oriented operations. At JPF Metacast Pvt. Ltd., students observed the complete metal casting and machining cycle, along with modern

technologies such as CNC, VMC, and CMM systems. The visit highlighted the importance of quality control, productivity, and global trade practices.

On 28th February, students attended a Digital Marketing Conference focused on women empowerment, where they explored social media marketing, content creation, and audience engagement strategies.

Overall, the visit effectively bridged the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical understanding of industrial processes, technology, and contemporary business practices.

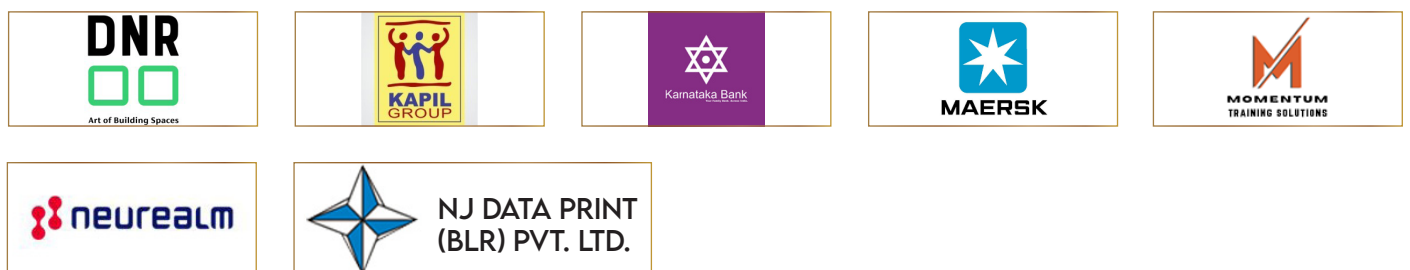
